



## Instructions for Complete Removal of Anti-Cloud Backup Service

1. Open Windows Settings and click on **Apps**.



2. On the **Apps & Features** screen, scroll down until you see Anti-Cloud and Anti-Cloud Backup and Restore.



3. First, click on Anti-Cloud and click **Uninstall**.


16. Check the box to 'Remove all user settings from this device', then click **Uninstall**.




17. After uninstall completes, click **Close**. You are done with the next step of the process.



18. Next click on the Windows Start Menu icon  and type in Registry Editor, then click Run as administrator



19. Click **Yes** when prompted by the UAC to continue. Expand HKEY\_CURRENT\_USER, then SOFTWARE. Right click AntiCloud-GUI and choose Delete.



20. Confirm the deletion by clicking **Yes**. You can then close the Registry Editor.



21. Open **File Explorer** and go to **C:\Users\{Current\_User}** (Current\_User will be the name of the user logged in) and right click on the AntiCloud folder. Then choose Delete and click **Yes** to confirm.



22. Right click the **Anti-Cloud Admin** icon on the desktop and choose **Delete**. Restart the PC and the uninstall of the Anti-Cloud Backup and Restore service is complete.
